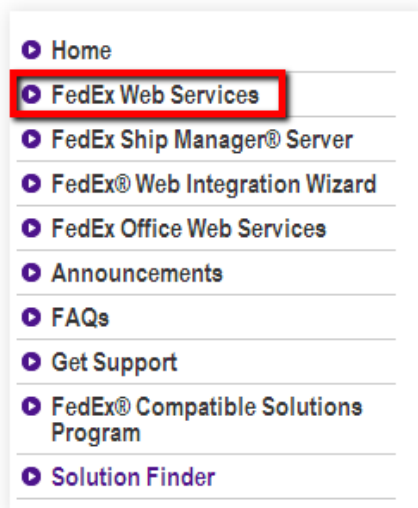


Getting your FedEx Account Details

If you haven't already, sign up for a FedEx account by going [here](#).

1. Go to the **FedEx Developer Resource Center's Solution Finder** and click on FedEx Web Services (located under Home on the left-hand side).



2. Click the **Move to Production** link.



3. Click on the **Get Production Key** that appears under the production menu.

Moving to Production

Customers moving to production will need a new set of credentials that will replace the test credentials currently in their application. Credentials include Meter Number, Authentication Key, and Password. A production meter number is required for each location, however the key and password can be used among multiple locations.

Note: FedEx account billing contact information is required to complete the production registration process.
